MÉTIS CROSSING

Look no further for an immersive cultural experience. Métis Crossing, the first major Métis cultural interpretive centre in Alberta, is a one-of-a-kind attraction that encourages visitors to participate in activities that promote appreciation of the people, customs, and celebrations. Learn traditional Métis art from teachers and knowledge holders who host classes using traditional materials, beading, and jewellery making techniques, and stay the night at the brand new 40-room boutique lodge that was designed by Métis architect Tiffany Shaw-Collinge. Each room is curated by a Métis artist and features traditional art and storytelling. The beds each have a hand sewn quilt made by women from the New Dawn Métis Women's Society, which guests have the option to purchase at the end of their stay!

Métis Crossing has welcomed the return of heritage species to traditional Métis Lands. Experience the Visions, Hopes and Dreams Wildlife tour, where you'll spot Woods Bison, Plains Bison, White Bison, Elk, White Elk, and Percheron horses.

YEG SCOOT

Scoot your way around the North Saskatchewan River Valley, as you explore the trails and pathways that weave their way through it. Stop at some of Edmonton's top local attractions and take in the picture-perfect views along the way. Edmonton's River Valley is known as the largest urban park in Canada with more than 160 kilometers (about 99.42 mi) of maintained pathways and 20 major parks. Plus enjoy a private group picnic at one of Edmonton's best picnic spots.

FORT EDMONTON PARK INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EXPERIENCE

The Indigenous Peoples Experience at Fort Edmonton Park is an awe-inspiring exhibit that explores the rich and beautiful cultures of First Nations and Métis Peoples while encouraging visitors to seek out the truths as lived by Indigenous Peoples before and after Canada became a country. The stories, music, artwork, and text in the experience come from local Indigenous perspectives and voices, gathered through engagement with local Indigenous people. These stories, teachings, and memories have been passed through millennia. They reflect a rich and resilient history and deep connection to the land and seasons. In addition, learn about early settlers and the fur trade by touring the 1846 Fort, test your shooting skills in the Shooting Gallery, soar to the heavens on a 1920s-style Ferris wheel, and fill up on classic midway fare.

OLD RED BARN FARM TO FLAME EXPERIENCE

Located just 7 minutes from the Edmonton International Airport is the Old Red Barn, a beautifully restored 1950's barn that hosts spectacular long table dinners, cooking classes & events.

In this demonstration style cooking class, learn how to cook over open fire by an experienced Pitt Master. Inspired by great Chefs like Francis Mallmann from Chefs Table, the unique open fire cooking experience is sure to excite all your senses. Menus are designed around what is seasonally available from surrounding local farms. Get expert tips on cooking with flame and engage in the process of making fire cooked food.



VIP HELI TOUR + PICNIC IN THE WOODS AT PRAIRIE GARDENS

Soar to new heights as you take in panoramic views of the city and make your way to Prairie Gardens and Adventure Farm from the privacy of a helicopter! Follow the majestic River Valley (the largest stretch of urban parkland in North America) to Edmonton's Downtown Ice District, catching iconic sights along the way, including Fort Edmonton Park, The Valley Zoo, Hawrelak Park and Rogers Place to name a few.



Next, travel over canola and wheat fields, a patchwork of crops and boreal forest where you'll find yourself amidst lush pumpkin patches, rows of sprouting vegetables, and meticulously groomed gardens at Prairie Gardens. Step back in time as you are greeted by a tractor drawn wagon— your transportation through the gardens. Meet an amazing local farmer who has arranged your private farm to-table picnic in a 40-acre woods preserve. The menu has been carefully selected to showcase fresh, organic, creative cuisine that will delight you!
