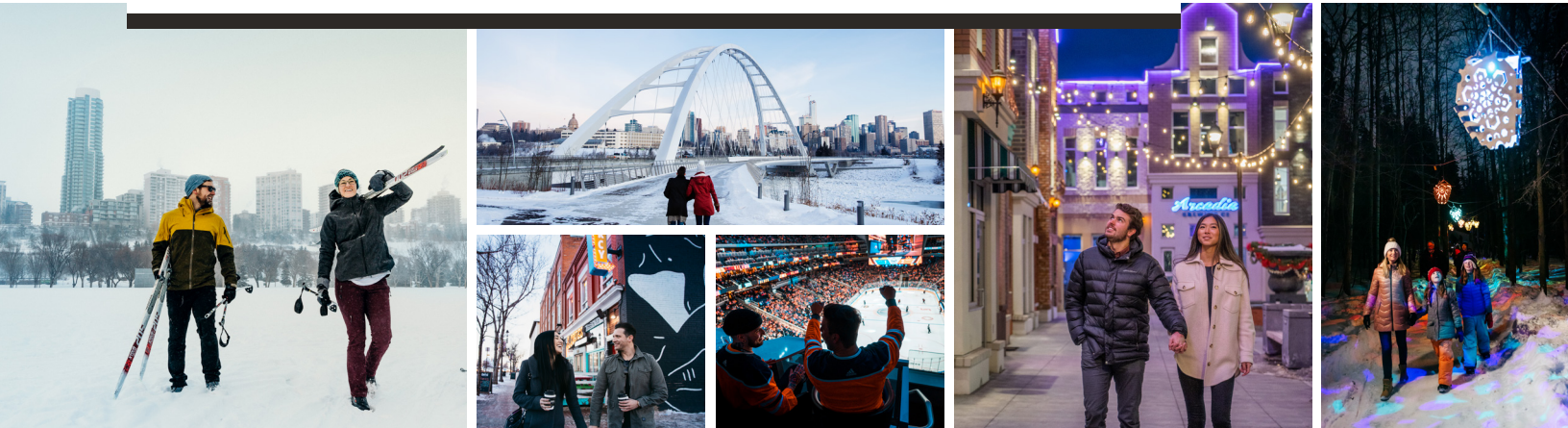

RESTAURANTS

UCCELLINO

Uccellino has some of the best Italian cuisine in Canada. This downtown gem introduces customers to unique Italian flavours through their incomparable food and wine. TRES CARNALES ROSTIZADO

Featuring an old-world cooking concept made modern, Rostizado brings the style, spice and flare of Mexico's rosticcerias in food best-devoured family-style. 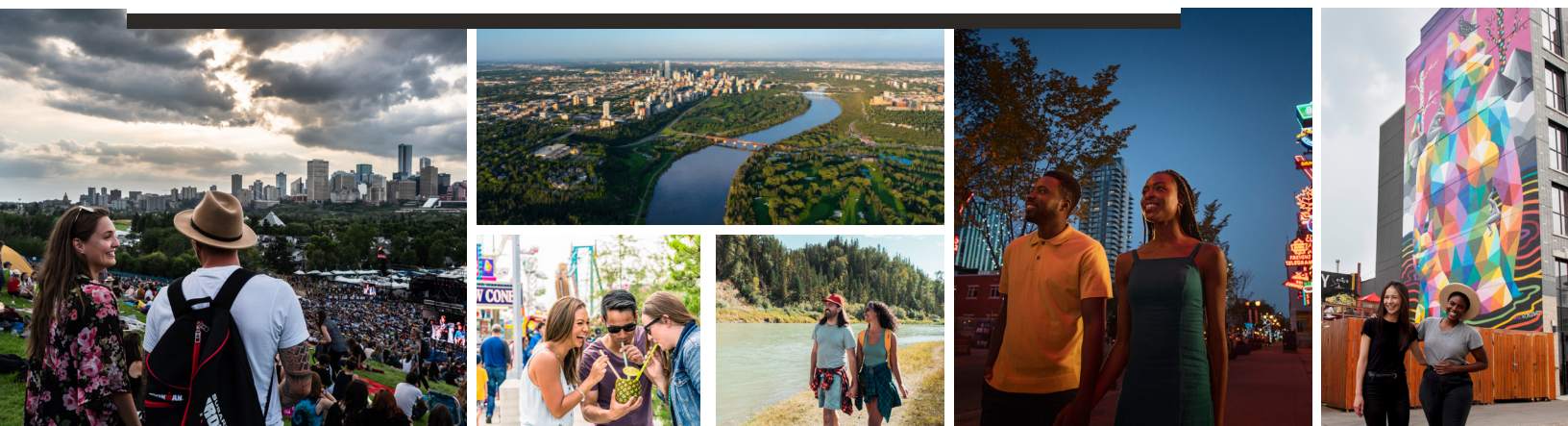

JAPONAIS BISTRO

COFFEE SHOPS

ROSEWOOD FOODS

Situated downtown across from the Stanley A. Milner Library, this cozy spot churns out all the comfort food you could possibly want. Plus, their lively selection of brunch cocktails and organic wines pair perfectly with a morning meal. Don't forget to grab a delectable macaroon or cruller to start your day off the right way!

COFFEE BUREAU

Jasper Avenue's Coffee Bureau features all kinds of shine: from the 1950s Italian brass chandelier and fancy customized Izzo espresso machine to the bright smiles of husband and wife owners. Coffee Bureau serves locally roasted Ace Coffee and Steven Smith teas alongside freshly baked cookies, muffins, croissants and gluten-free nibbles.

CREDO

Credo is a set of sibling coffee shops well-known amongst locals for their quality coffee (and London Fogs for those non-coffee folks). Each cup of Credo coffee is filled with feel-good flavour. Their coffee is direct trade, ensuring their growers are paid 25% higher rates than fair trade prices.

LOCK STOCK COFFEE

At Lock Stock, espresso is pulled with care, savoury biscuits are baked fresh and heated to order, and English muffins are fried daily for a variety of sandwiches, making them a necessary stop when in the downtown neighbourhood.

GRAB & GO

TRES CARNALES TAQUERIA

Tres Carnales is a downtown, laid-back staple, putting a modern twist on traditional recipes. To top it all off the menu always features a rotating veggie taco and local brewery Alley Kat, even made a custom cerveza, Lupita Especial just for Tres. Grab a Jarrito, some fish tacos, but try to wait until you're finished before you order seconds.

KB & CO.

kb&co's plant-based menu is free of meat, dairy, egg, and soy products, and they commit to using all organic and local ingredients whenever possible. Stay for a bite in the bright, comfortable and inviting space, or take any menu item to go.

FARROW

Farrow focuses on using local ingredients and bringing in some of the best coffee from independent roasters from all over the world. They created a menu that is constantly changing and evolving. In the first 10 months being open, they served over 100 different sandwiches!

JACK'S BURGER SHACK

With almost a dozen burger options to choose from and shake options named Darth Vader and Italian Stallion, Jack's Burger Shack has raised the bar on burgers in Edmonton. Partnering with D'Arcy's Meat Market to serve the highest quality beef, along with freshly baked buns, hand cut fries and house made sauces have made their burger a local favourite.
