DAY 1

Arrive in Edmonton

Edmonton is a vibrant urban centre in the heart of the wilderness. We barbecue in blizzards and throw axes for fun. From close encounters with free roaming bison to surfing indoors to tackling the trails of North America's largest expanse of urban parkland, you'll find there's uniqueness to how Edmontonians do ordinary things.

Telus World of Science

The Zeidler Dome is being re-imagined! The new theatre will be a 21st-century digital visualization theatre, connecting scientific research with computer visualization and 10k resolution to help us understand how the universe works! You'll have the opportunity to view the night sky and northern lights like never before!



Shopping Districts

Popular Shopping areas include independent boutiques in historic Old Strathcona on Whyte Avenue and a dozen fine art galleries on 124th street. **TIP: no provincial sales tax means more money for shopping.**

West Edmonton Mall

West Edmonton Mall is the Mt. Everest of indoor entertainment, shopping, and attractions in North America. A place you have to visit at least once in your lifetime! Part adventure park entertainment complex, shopping and dining destination, the mall spans the equivalent of 48 city blocks!





Let out a gasp of excitement as you slip in from the cold into the tropical setting of the World Waterpark, home to the world's largest indoor wave pool. Later, climb aboard a full-sized replica of the Santa Maria, or skate beneath the stars under a glass dome. Explore more than 400 hectares (988 acres) of parks and over 130km (80 mi) of walking, cycling, hiking and cross-country skiing trails. When night falls, gaze in wonder at the awe inspiring northern lights.

Northern Lights Aurora Viewing

Witness Mother Nature's greatest light show on an aurora borealis guided tour with Northern Lights Outdoor Excursions. You'll venture into a boreal forest with a knowledgeable guide, garner expert tips from a professional photographer, take a tour of the night sky with an onsite astronomer and end the evening with refreshments and a taste of local cuisine.

MacDonald Island Curling Demonstration

A true Canadian experience! Learn about the game of curling and put your skills to the test in a friendly competition! For those who are new to curling, here's how it works: two teams of four take turns sliding heavy, polished granite stones (in curling circles these are called "rocks") across a narrow ice sheet towards the house (a circular target marked on the ice). The purpose is to get the stones resting closest to the centre of the house at the conclusion of each end, which is completed once both teams have thrown all eight of their stones.

Discover the superior quality of freshlycrafted local beer at one of the largest brewpubs in Canada. Visitors can choose from a long-list of crowd-pleasing traditional and signature menu items, including the pub's famous all-day brunch.




Oil Sands Discovery Centre
