Edmonton Pro Rodeo crowns first Miss Rodeo Edmonton

Edmonton - The Edmonton Pro Rodeo (EPR) is honoured to announce that Codi Wilson has been crowned as the first ever Miss Rodeo Edmonton.

Applicants competed in various areas such as public speaking on air with CFCW host A.J. Keller, testing their rodeo knowledge though a written exam and testing their horsemanship skills by completing various patterns showing how they manage their horse while maintaining posture and balance. Until Wilson's reign concludes in 2024, she will be an ambassador for the Edmonton Pro Rodeo attending rodeos and other events throughout the year.

The Miss Rodeo Edmonton 2023 competition and crowning took place at the Sturgeon Agriplex Society Arena, the Pure Casino Yellowhead and the Edmonton EXPO Centre on May 18 and 19. EPR would like to thank all the partners and judges who came on board to make this first year a success.

"It is a true honour to have been selected as the first ever Miss Rodeo Edmonton," said Codi Wilson. "I look forward to being able to meet so many new people and bridge the gap between rural and city roots while educating people further on the heritage of the great sport of rodeo that we love so much. Wilson is a 23-year-old third generation cowgirl who was born and raised on a farm just south of Sundre, Alberta. The sport of rodeo has been a huge part of her life since she was a young girl. Wilson began competing in junior rodeos at a very young age as her family traveled the rodeo circuits in Alberta. She became a member of the Alberta High School Rodeo Association when she was in grade six and remained a member until she graduated from high school in 2018. Throughout her years in this association, Wilson competed in barrel racing, pole bending, goat tying, break-away roping and girls cutting.

The second annual Edmonton Pro Rodeo runs September 29 – 30, 2023 at the Flair Airlines Hangar at the Edmonton EXPO Centre.
